11:00 a.m. Bylaw No. 2021-73: Zoning Bylaw Amendment, Parcel B and Parcel C, LSD 16 12-17-18 W2 (AR to CR3-C)

Manager of Planning & Development Paige Boha gave an overview of Bylaw No. 2021-73 being a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2019-20 known as the Zoning Bylaw by rezoning Parcel B and Parcel C, LSD 16 NE 12-17-18 W2M from CR1 - Country Residential 1 District to CR3 - Country Residential District 3.

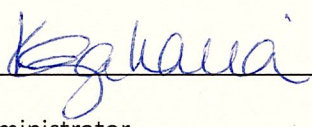
