


Bylaw No. 2017-33

A Bylaw to regulate the speed limit of motor vehicles.


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* (meaning a road allowance or a road, street or lane vested in the Crown in right of Saskatchewan or set aside for the purposes of the Crown in right of Saskatchewan pursuant to The North-West Territories Act or any Act, and includes anything erected on or in connection with the public highway); but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuance of such Act.
 - (b) "vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Traffic Safety Act*.
2. No person shall operate a vehicle at a greater speed than **60 kilometres per hour** on a public highway at the following locations: (map attached)
 - (a) The road east of NE Section 19 and Section 30 and 31-17-18-W2;
 - (b) The road east of Pt. NE 21 and Sections 28 & 33-16-18-W2 and Sections 4 & Pt. 9-17-18 W2M;
 - (c) The road east of Sections 4 and 9-17-17-W2 and Sections 16, 21, 28 and 33-17-17-W2;
 - (d) The road north of Section 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36-17-17-W2 and Sections 31, 32, 33, 34 and NW 35-17-17-W2;
 - (e) The road north of Section 8, 9, 10 and 11-18-17-W2
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected on all roads at the above-noted locations, and shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone area.
4.
 - (a) A person contravening any provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and is liable to a penalty of:
 - i) First offence \$100.00
 - ii) Second offence \$200.00
 - iii) Third offence \$300.00
 - (b) A person contravening any provisions of this bylaw with four or more offences shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
 - (c) A person contravening any provisions of this bylaw who has been served with a summons ticket and the penalty amount is \$300.00 or less and who wishes to plead guilty and pay a voluntary payment within 14 days of the date of the summons ticket, may deliver the summons and an amount equal to 50% of the specified penalty sum for the offence to a place indicated on the summons ticket on or before the date specified on the summons.
5. Bylaw No. 2017-17 is hereby repealed.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final reading and approval of Council.

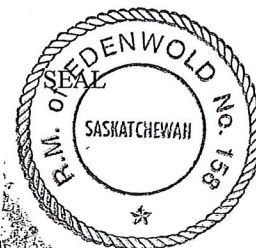
