



### **Parking of Recreational Vehicles in the R.M of Edenwold No. 158**

The Rural Municipality of Edenwold's Council has approved a text amendment to the Zoning Bylaw 2010-17 in regards to parking of recreational vehicles. The new regulations are listed below. If you have any questions please call our Planning Department at (306) 771-2034.

- No parking of any motor home, any travel trailer, fifth wheel trailer, boat or any similar vehicle shall be permitted in the front yard, including driveways and legal front yard parking stalls from November 1 to April 1, inclusive.
- Seasonal restrictions do not apply to tent trailers, truck campers, canoes, kayaks, snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, jet skis, or trailers designed to carry one of these items.
- A licensed or unlicensed recreational vehicle may be parked in the front yard in a legal parking spot, seasonal front yard parking restrictions may apply.
- The parking of any licensed or unlicensed vehicles, including a recreational vehicle, on the lawn or other areas of the front yard is prohibited.
- The total number of recreational vehicles per property cannot exceed two. This total includes both unlicensed and licensed recreational vehicles.
- Licensed and unlicensed recreational vehicles may be parked in the side and/or rear yard provided that they comply with the recreational vehicle limit of a maximum of 2 recreational vehicles.
- Recreational vehicles must be parked a minimum of 2 meters (6.5 feet) from the street.
- An RV and any other vehicle cannot be parked on a street, avenue, or highway at one place for any period of time exceeding twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.
- A Discretionary Use Application is required for storage of three (3) or more recreational vehicles on one lot in CR1- Country Residential, CR2- Country Residential, COM1- General Commercial and IND1- General Industrial.
- A Discretionary Use Application is required for storage of five (5) or more recreational vehicles on one lot in AR- Agricultural Resource.
