**Weekly Curb-Side Waste Collection (Automated) and
Bi-weekly Curb-Side Single Stream Recycling Collection (Automated)**

Council has secured the services of Loraas Disposal for weekly garbage collection and bi-weekly single stream recycling collection services within the following subdivisions.

Bridlewood Estates, Mission Pointe Estates, Stone Pointe Estates, Rock Pointe Estates, Escott Estates, Park Meadow Estates, Meadow Ridge Estates, Crawford Developments, Bohach and Deneve Subdivisions

Council believes the curb-side waste and recycling cart collection service is efficient, clean and good for the environment. The service will now be easily accessible and we encourage you to utilize the service.

If you are currently receiving collection services from Loraas Disposal your annual invoice will be automatically forwarded to the RM for payment.

Weekly Curb-Side Garbage Collection

1. Collections carts will be delivered to your residence within the next few weeks.
2. Commencing May 1st collection days will be every **Wednesday**. See attached schedule.
3. Carts must be at the road side by 7am in the morning. The enclosed brochure provides information and guidelines for the proper use of the system. Please keep the brochure for future reference.

Bi-weekly Curb-Side Single Stream Recycling Collection

1. Collection carts will be delivered to your residence near the end of May.
2. The first recycle collection date is **Thursday, June 13, 2013** and service will continue on a bi-weekly basis thereafter. See attached schedule.
3. Carts must be at the road side by 7am in the morning. The enclosed brochure explains the recycling system and provides a list of acceptable recycling materials. Do not bag your recyclables. Please keep the brochure for future reference.
4. Glass is not an acceptable recyclable material at this time. Do not put glass in the recycle cart.

The effects from the burning of unknown materials and their content is dangerous to people and the environment. The burning of garbage, leaves or other flammable/combustible waste material within residential subdivisions is prohibited. Open fires may occur in a recreational-use pit provided the material being burned is clean, dry wood. In all cases, smoke and fumes or other matter from an open air fire shall not cause a nuisance to others. Any person found guilty of an infraction under the burning bylaw is liable to a penalty of up to \$10,000.
