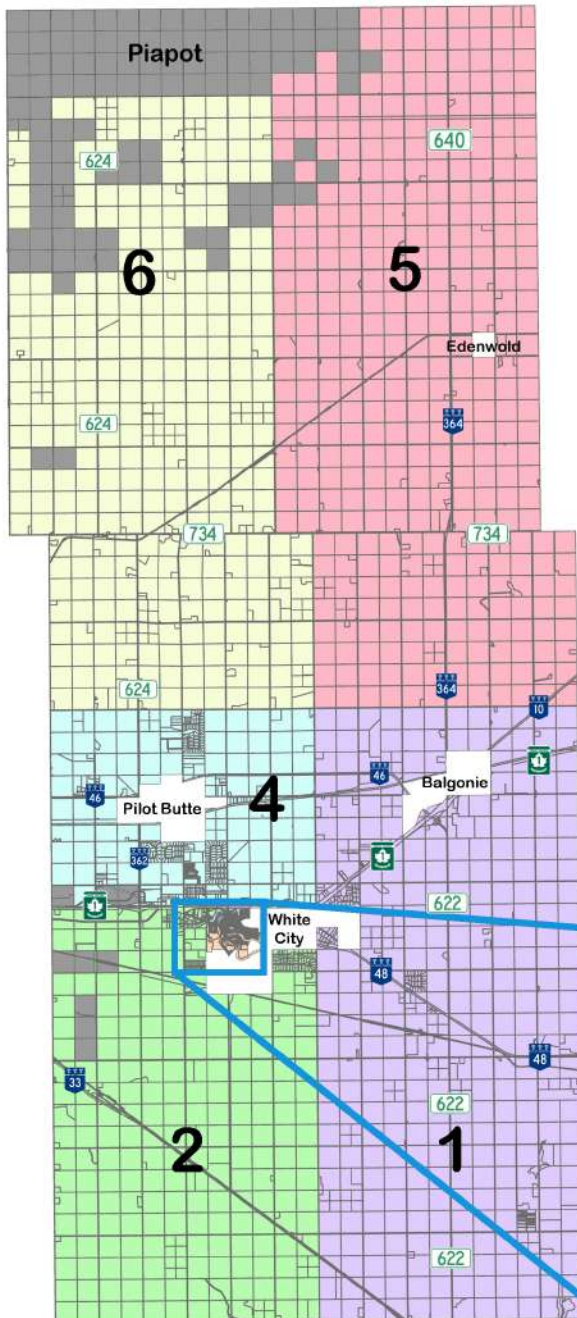

The Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158 was incorporated in 1912, located in Treaty 4 territory in southeastern Saskatchewan, just 10 kms east of Regina. Our current population is 4,422. Our boundaries include 849 km² of land containing a wide range of commercial, residential, and industrial land uses.

The RM has three business districts: Emerald Park Business District, Butte Business District, and Highway 46 Business Park. The RM's neighbours include six First Nations and six other municipalities.

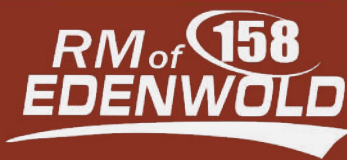

HOW DO I GET MY MAIL?



The RM of Edenwold takes care of civic addressing.
Canada Post handles your mail.

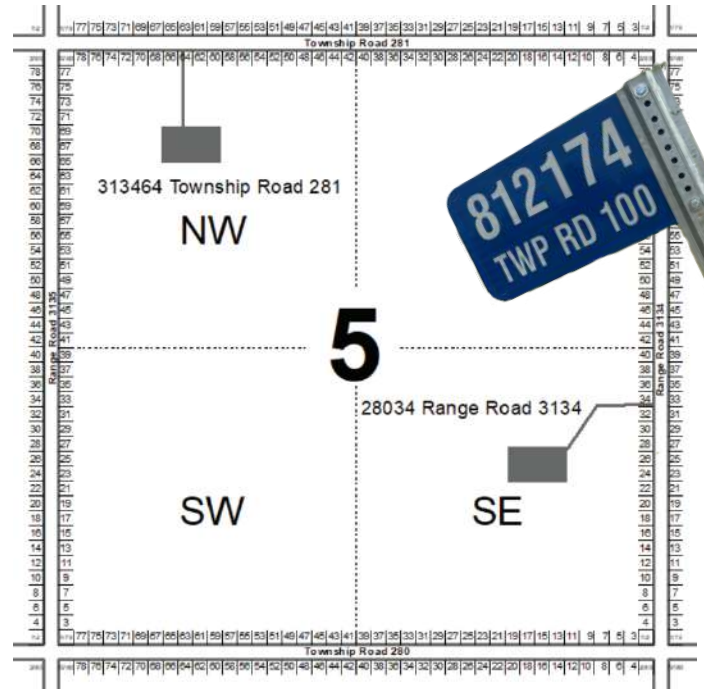
Your first step to ensure you are getting your mail is to visit the nearest post office. Rural Saskatchewan traditionally relies on central pick-up locations, post offices, or group boxes, not urban-style door delivery.

Head to your nearest Canada Post outlet/post office with your government ID and rent a box as your mailing address.

Then contact the RM office to ensure you are also aware of your civic address, if required, as this will be used for emergency matters and first responders.

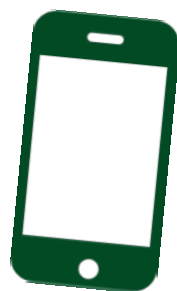

HOW DO YOU READ YOUR CIVIC ADDRESS?

Civic addresses are registered on the Civic Address Registry (CAR) system and are available to 911-First Responders during emergencies. The program, supported by the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency, is not for the delivery of mail or packages.

Garbage collection, recycling & composting



We encourage all residents to adopt a comprehensive approach to waste management by embracing the principles of Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle. We partner with Loraas Disposal for collection. Learn more about your pick-up dates on the RM website or check out www.loraasdisposal.com directly.

The RM organizes spring clean-up bins in May and fall clean-up bins in September/October. These bins, located on Hutchence Road past the RM Office, are for leaves, branches, and grass.

The RM also hosts a yearly Household Hazardous Waste Day in the fall to allow residents to drop off their HHW for safe disposal.



We have fire protection agreements with Balgonie, White City, Pilot Butte, the Village of Edenwold, and the Hamlet of Kronau, but it's still recommended that all residents have adequate fire insurance. Learn more about our Community Safety Officer Program and Fire Department.

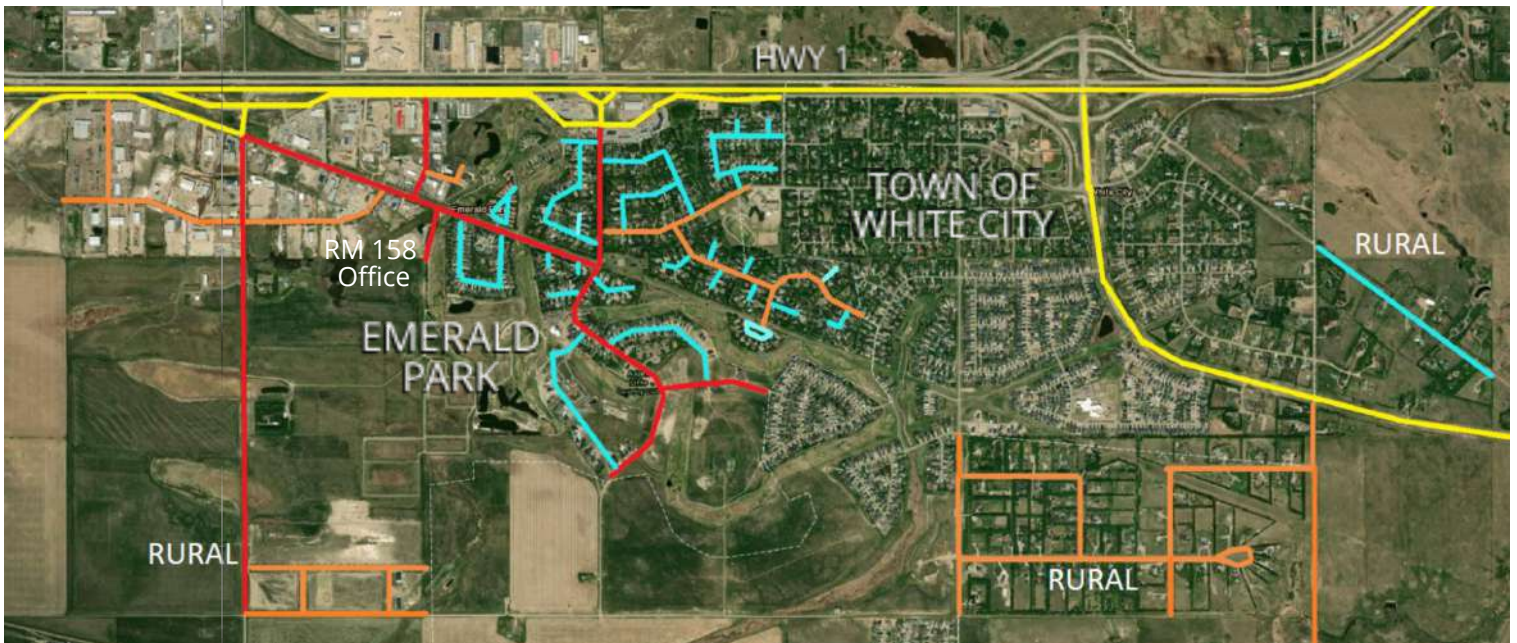
ROADS

The RM maintains over 675 kilometres of roads across the municipality, which includes 15 country residential subdivisions and Emerald Park.

Alongside gravel grading and pavement crack filling, RM Public Works staff are also involved in many other aspects of road maintenance.



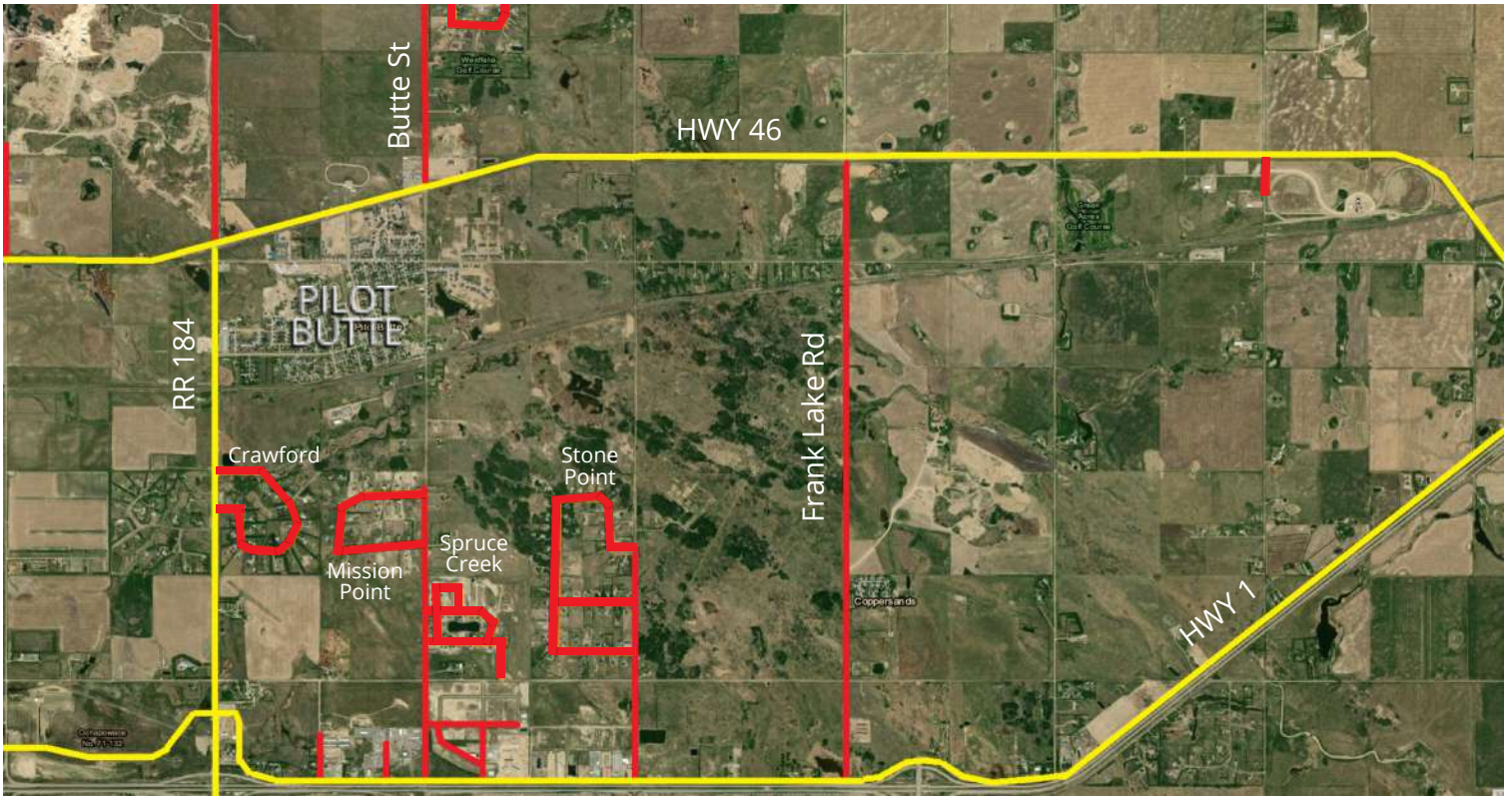
After a heavy snowfall, public works staff prioritize the order in which roads are plowed. We strive to provide a fair and equal service during and after snowstorms. Our main high-traffic grid roads, and country residential developments, receive top priority. Bus routes get cleared as a matter of course with all other roads, but in extreme conditions, bus routes are given priority.



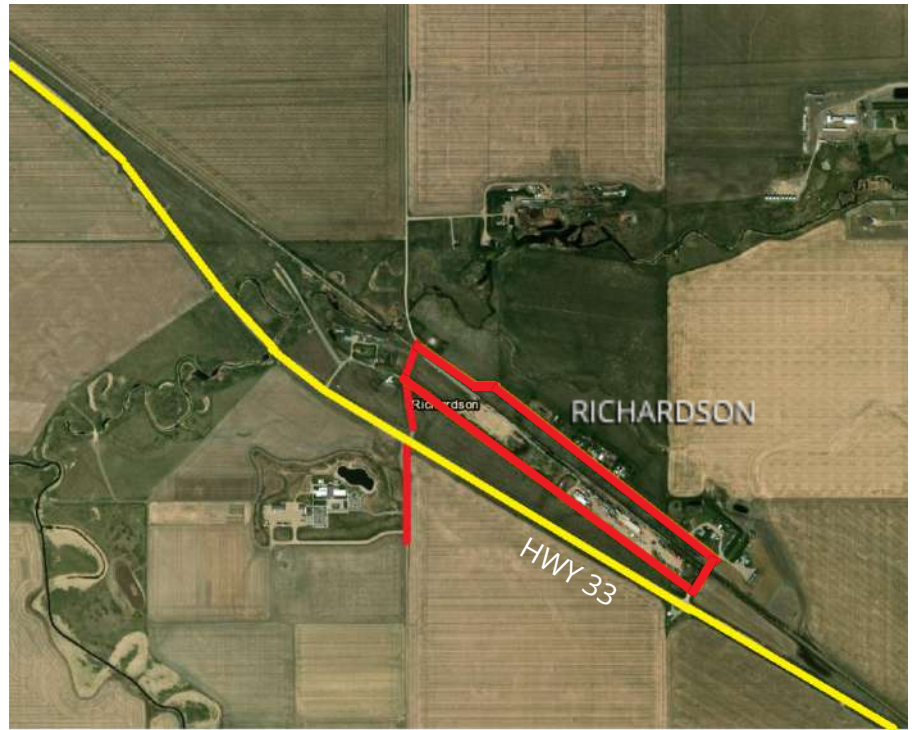
SNOW REMOVAL IN EMERALD PARK

The RM of Edenwold is proud of its strong rural and agricultural community.

With nearly 348 sections of land—and more than 70% devoted to farming and rural use—the RM's agricultural producers, acreage owners, and rural residents play a vital role in our local economy and quality of life.

Dust control is an important part of maintaining safe and comfortable living conditions for residents within the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158. Gravel road dust can reduce visibility, affect air quality, create health concerns, and impact everyday life for residents, businesses, and visitors.

If you would like your road managed for dust, please submit your request to the RM Office before the end of April each year.



Ratepayers are required to call the Provincial Controlled Burn Line at (866) 404-4911 before beginning any controlled burns. If a fire department responds to a call reported from a passerby and you do not report your controlled burn, you may be fined.

CONTROLLED BURNS



PLANTS, TREES & INVASIVE SPECIES CONTROL

The proper cultivation of land and control of noxious weeds is encouraged throughout the municipality. If a noxious weed is spreading due to neglect, the RM may take action against the perpetrator under the provisions of *The Weed Control Act*.

SARM manages an Invasive Plant Control Program that can be used to subsidize the purchase and application of eligible herbicides.



PUBLIC HEARINGS

Throughout the year, the RM of Edenwold hosts many public hearings and open houses on a variety of matters that may be of interest to you. This is your chance to have your say! Events are listed on the RM website and shared out on social media and via a Voyent Alert!
