

## Bylaw No. 2026 – 25

### R.M. of Edenwold No. 158

#### A Bylaw to Set Levies for the Purposes of Providing Waste, Recycling, and Compost Collection Services

Whereas, pursuant to Clauses 312, 313, and 314 of *The Municipalities Act*, a municipality may pass a special tax bylaw to raise revenue to pay for any specific service to be completed within the taxation year for properties that will benefit from the specific service.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

#### **1. DEFINITIONS**

In this Bylaw, including this section:

- 1.1 **Administrator** shall mean the administrator of the Municipality appointed pursuant to Section 110 of *The Municipalities Act*.
- 1.2 **Compost Opt-In/Opt-Out Form** shall mean the Compost Opt-In/Opt-Out Form included in the Municipality's *Form Policy*.
- 1.3 **Council** shall mean the elected representatives of the Municipality.
- 1.4 **Country Residential Subdivisions** shall mean the residential subdivisions of, including but not limited to:
  - Bohach Estates;
  - Bridlewood Estates;
  - Casa Rosa Estates;
  - Crawford Developments;
  - Deneve Subdivision;
  - Escott Estates;
  - Jameson Estates;
  - Meadow Ridge Estates;
  - Mission Pointe Estates;
  - Park Meadow Estates;
  - Rock Pointe Estates;
  - Spruce Creek Estates;
  - Stone Pointe Estates; and
  - Vista Springs
- 1.5 **Emerald Park** shall mean the residential subdivision of Emerald Park.
- 1.6 **Municipality** shall mean the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158.

#### **2. GENERAL REGULATIONS**

- 2.1 This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Sanitation Levy Bylaw".
- 2.2 Annual sanitation taxes are not eligible for discounts or prompt payment incentives.

#### **3. EMERALD PARK COLLECTION LEVY**

- 3.1 All residential properties in Emerald Park shall be charged an annual sanitation tax of \$203.96 per parcel for weekly curbside garbage collection, bi-weekly single stream curb-side recycling collection service, and seasonal curb-side compost collection.
- 3.2 Pursuant to 3.1, any person residing in Emerald Park wishing to opt-out of the seasonal curb-side compost collection shall submit a Compost Opt-In/Opt-Out Form to the Administrator.

- 3.3 Pursuant to 3.2, the fee charged to residential properties in Emerald Park who opt-out of compost collection shall be \$187.05.

**4. COUNTRY RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION LEVY**

- 4.1 All residential properties in Country Residential Subdivisions shall be charged an annual sanitation tax of \$187.05 per parcel for weekly curbside garbage collection and bi-weekly single stream curbside recycling collection.
- 4.2 Pursuant to 4.1, any person residing in a Country Residential Subdivision wishing to opt-in to the seasonal curbside compost collection shall submit a Compost Opt-In/Opt-Out Form to the Administrator.
- 4.3 Pursuant to 4.2, the fee charged to residential properties in Country Residential Subdivisions who opt-in to compost collection shall be \$203.96.

**5. INSPECTION, ENFORCEMENT, AND PENALITIES**

- 5.1 The administration and enforcement of this Bylaw is hereby delegated to the Administrator.
- 5.2 All disputes arising from the administration of this Bylaw shall be referred to Council, and Council shall be the final authority in all cases.

**6. SEVERABILITY**

- 6.1 This Bylaw shall not be construed to hold the Municipality or its agents responsible or liable for any damage to persons or property caused through the administration of this Bylaw.
- 6.2 If a court of competent jurisdiction should declare any part, section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this Bylaw to be invalid, that portion shall not be construed as having persuaded or influenced Council to pass the remainder of this Bylaw. The part, section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this Bylaw is to be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and the holding of the Court shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Bylaw.

**7. REPEAL**

- 7.1 Bylaw No. 2025-14 and all subsequent amendments are hereby repealed.

**8. COMING INTO FORCE**

- 8.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
