Manager of Planning & Development Paige Boha gave an overview of the discretionary use application for a home-based business, rural (construction business) at SW 30-18-18 W2.

Reeve Huber asked for written submissions in regards to the discretionary use application. Manager of Planning & Development Paige Boha informed Council that there were four (4) written submissions received and read them aloud. All four written submissions were opposed to the discretionary use application citing this property is currently not in compliance with the RM bylaws in which various demolition materials are dumped, stored, burnt and buried on the property, increase of traffic, potential negative impacts to ground water, animal neglect, snow dumping without proper approvals, soil processing business operating without prior approvals and non-compliance with the nuisance bylaw hours of operations.

Reeve Huber asked for any verbal submissions. Ratepayer Rob Stewart spoke to council with his concerns how this property is in contravention of multiple regulations of the RM's zoning bylaw and nuisance bylaw. Also, his property value has decreased due to the visual of the property.
