This position requires the safe operation of a variety of heavy equipment and the ability to work independently and as part of a team in all weather conditions.

Key Responsibilities

As a Public Works Operator, your responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Perform rural road maintenance, light construction projects, and snow removal operations.
- Operate and maintain tandem gravel trucks, semi gravel trucks, motor graders, tractors, and other municipal equipment in a safe and efficient manner.
- Conduct daily equipment inspections, maintenance, and operational checks.
- Ensure municipal equipment, facilities, and work areas are kept clean, safe, and organized.
- Demonstrate a commitment to high-quality workmanship and continuous improvement.
- Maintain awareness of changing technologies, equipment, and operational techniques.
- Follow municipal safety procedures and best practices at all times.
- Assist with the general care and maintenance of municipal infrastructure and community assets.
- Work independently and collaboratively with other employees to meet operational goals and timelines.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Assistant Manager of Public Works and/or Rural Lead Operator.
