Discussion the possible Annexation of Parcel M into their boundaries. Discussion went around the table with the following points made by Council being noted:

Our Official Community Plan which was adopted by the Ministry of Government Relations in August of 2011 has Emerald Park as part of our growth plan, our intentions have been to grow Emerald Park and to grow cohesively with White City, we have invested millions of dollars in water and sewer infrastructure in the past couple years to help us achieve this and Parcel M has always been part of our growth plan. We are able to provide all the services required for a proposed subdivision to proceed on Parcel M within our jurisdiction. We promote growth and we promote development and that includes not only agricultural, industrial, commercial & country residential but also residential growth in Emerald Park. We understand Urban Municipalities require land to grow and we know White City currently has 3 quarters of land to grow into and therefore there is no "immediate need" for a larger land base being demonstrated by the Town of White City for this parcel of land.
