With a quorum present, Reeve Huber called the meeting to order @ 3:00 p.m.

Joel informed Council that due to the Covid 19 pandemic Minister Carr has had to postpone the March 24th, 2020 meeting. Council discussed when the meeting is rescheduled, they will take the opportunity to inform the Minister of the concerns and frustrations the RM has and is dealing with as a result of White City's Annexation attempt. Among the issues Council is dealing with is the SMB process and its lack of transparency. Any money obtained from this grant would lessen the financial burden on the RM's share of the costs.
